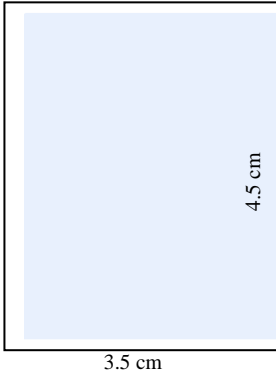

E. FINANCING YOUR EDUCATION

How do you intend to finance your studies at Tyndale? In addition to transportation to and from your homeland, living and educational expenses are at least 9300 Euros a year for a single student. Acceptance for admission to Tyndale Theological Seminary is **not** the same as an offer of student financial aid from the seminary. In granting a visa, the Dutch government requires evidence that the student has the necessary funding for at least a year, thus the visa application process will not be initiated until Tyndale is satisfactorily and explicitly shown financial proof of funding.

* If you wish to apply for consideration for aid from Tyndale's own limited funds for that purpose, you must provide full information on your present resources and how much you are expecting or already counting on from others.

Keep in mind that students from outside the European Union are restricted in employment in the Netherlands.

NOTE: *It is very difficult and expensive for spouses or children from outside the European Union to accompany a student to Tyndale. The school provides no financial assistance for this purpose.*

NOTE: The Netherlands requires that **all** students have medical and hospitalization insurance. If you do not have a policy, you will be required to purchase insurance. Applicants are responsible to check with the Dutch consulate in their home countries to determine which, if any, immunizations the Dutch government requires for entry.

IMPORTANT: Most medical insurance policies cover **only** emergency and accident related dental service.

Under some conditions, we may allow an equivalent demonstration of proficiency in the English language.

3. Indicate why you are interested in the possibility of studying at Tyndale Theological Seminary and how this will serve your ministry goals, to the extent that you presently discern the Lord's leading. Include, if known, where and in what role(s) (pastor, teacher, evangelist, etc.) you expect or hope to serve following Tyndale.

Tyndale will make a provisional evaluation based on the information provided on this form, together with the photocopies requested in sector B provided on this form, and the statements from section E and H. For final admission we also require four statements to be sent with the Tyndale recommendation form, one each from:

- (a) an employer, work supervisor, or professional colleague
- (b) a pastoral or Christian leader with whom you have served
- (c) a teacher or other academic mentor, especially able to judge your capability for university level study
- (d) a leader in your home congregation or the one in which you are currently most active
