Two English-language classes will be offered at the Tyndale main campus for the spring of 2010 at the dates and times noted below. Both will be on Thursday evenings although one option includes four Saturday classes as well.

New Testament Survey and Backgrounds (NT 500) 5 ECTS

Content: Have you ever wanted to learn more about the message and purpose of the New Testament? This course will provide an overview of the main ideas within each of the New Testament books. It also will examine issues of why a book is included in the New Testament, authorship, date, purpose, and the origin of each book. Content will be examined academically as well as with attention to the Church. For those who come to the four Saturday classes (11.00-16.00 on 3/27, 4/24, and 5/29; Final exam: 10.00-12.00 on 6/5), they also will learn about the world of the New Testament and how it impacts our understanding of the Bible.

OT 753 Ecclesiastes and Ruth 3 ECTS

Professor: Dr. Ed Curtis

Content: How should the believer act when faced with life's challenges, tensions, and difficulties? How should the believer respond when life does not seem to work out? What is the role of the Providence of God in all of this, especially in light of His unending love for His people? These and similar questions will be addressed via an exciting study of the Old Testament books of Ecclesiastes and Ruth.
